COURSE DESCRIPTION

This is a selective course for third-year undergraduates involving themselves in the *Outstanding English Major Undergraduates Program* of School of Foreign Languages (SFL), NENU.

This course consists three parts related to research methods on linguistics, translation and literature, which will be delivered by three teachers, Prof. Feng Wei (PhD), Associate Prof. Qu Yingmei (PhD) and Associate Prof. Liu Honggang (PhD) in SFL. Miss. Xie Yanan (Associate Research Librarian) at the library of NENU, is honorably invited to give three lectures on how to do digital research work online.

This course aims to introduce the basic concepts of research and the ways of doing scientific research in. Upon completing this course, students will obtain the knowledge on research design and ability of independent designing a study.

This course adopts the project-based learning and instruction (PBLI), requiring the students to complete the projects concerning with linguistics, translation and literature by teams. Students are also requested to finish the individual work. All the students will be assessed in formative ways. They will be given the final marks based on their completion of both team work and individual assignments.

The whole course will be delivered both online and offline. Students have to upload the required work and complete the offline work as teachers requested on time. Any delayed work will be REJECTED, which might negatively impact students' final assessments.
